Dr. LaShomb has a long-standing and profound passion for athletes, athletics, and Chiropractic health and is wholly committed to providing individuals and teams with the necessary care that enables them to excel in their sport.

Devoting her professional life to the field of athletic Chiropractic, Dr. LaShomb is known both nationally and internationally as a sports specialist in Chiropractic healthcare and has extensive clinical experience as an Athletic Trainer/Chiropractor at competitive games worldwide, including the World Games in Duisberg (2005), the US National Figure Skating Championships (2005), the Summer Olympic Games in Athens (2004), the Winter Olympic Games in Utah (2002), and the PGA Golf Tournament.
